Now in its fourth year, the tournament held at Mid Pines Golf Resort in Pinehurst, NC, and conducted by Rotarians of North Carolina, has raised approximately \$69,000 for the Homes children. Boys and Girls Homes of North Carolina, a not-for-profit childcare agency, provides residential, foster, and adoptive care for children birth to eighteen who have been removed from their home because of abuse, neglect or other related issues. North Carolina Rotarians have served thousands of children in partnership with Boys and Girls Homes since constructing Rotary Cottage for children to live in on the Homes campus in 1966.
